

How to use this Lesson Planner Template

- ❖ Print out several copies of this planner so you have several weeks' worth on hand
- ❖ Fill in the blanks with reading material/lessons/activities etc. for the upcoming week
- ❖ As you discover new ideas/activities/lessons etc. add them to an upcoming week
- ❖ Try to balance lessons/activities/projects so that there is something in every section
- ❖ Order/complete your areas/subjects/activities in any configuration you like (*you don't have to follow the order in which I've listed them*)
- ❖ Don't worry about filling in or completing every blank every week
- ❖ Don't worry about scheduling everything to a specific day in the week
- ❖ Use my templates as a guide to create your own unique homeschool style or fusion!

Tips for successful Lesson Planning:

- ❖ For reading time/Cozy Corner, I encourage you to include:
 - Parent Read-Aloud titles
 - Child Read-Aloud titles
 - Cross-curricular titles (*nonfiction as well as fiction, on topics of science or history*)
 - Silent-Sustained-Reading titles
- ❖ Decide ahead of time what YOU will be doing during each activity window so that you don't go insane with boredom, interrupt or help your child too much, or feel like you aren't getting your own work done. Jot down in the margin a few words or a symbol to remind you what to do. (*Example: for tray activity time you may write "fold laundry" or draw a sock in the margin. Or during writing time you may jot down "make grocery list".*)
- ❖ Consider theming your weeks (*such as Charlotte's Web week or Dragon week*) to help you limit your choices and plan cross-curricular activities accordingly.

REMEMBER: write your plans in pencil!! It's okay if your plans change or get postponed!
